What is the challenge?

HIT in NYCPS is currently being supported by ESSER funds through *June 2025*

How do we continue to fund HIT in NYC post-ESSER?

Two Options:

- Braid current state and federal funding options together to create a sustainable funding stream for HIT
- 2. Establish a HIT specific funding stream at the state level through legislation





What has already been tried?

Gov. Kathy Hochul's proposed HIT set-aside

- In January 2023 Gov. Hochul proposed \$250 million of Foundation Aid to be set aside for high-dosage tutoring in grades 3-8
- This proposal was rejected by both the NYS Senate and Assembly

What about this proposal needs to be changed to be favorable to NYS lawmakers?
