Since 2022, ExpandED Schools in partnership with New York City Public Schools (NYCPS) has supported the implementation of a city-wide HIT initiative. ExpandED Schools is an intermediary nonprofit serving as the backbone organization for the NYCPS HIT initiative. We connect vetted tutoring providers with participating schools to meet the diverse needs of New York City students.

What Makes Tutoring "High-Impact"?

High-Impact Tutoring (HIT) is a research-backed intervention that supplements classroom learning and is defined by these key components:

- **Consistent & Frequent:** Tutors meet with students at least **3 times per week**.
- **Low Ratio:** A trained tutor works with students in a small group of **1-to-4 or less**.
- **Relationship-Based:** Tutors are trained to build **strong, supportive relationships**.
- **Data-Driven:** **Tailored to student needs** and complements the school's curriculum.

Outcome Data

- **11,353 students across 106 schools in 12 community school districts** have received tutoring from 2022-2025 with **99% identifying** as students of color.
- HIT students in math tutoring exhibited a **median progress of 167%** on i-Readys typical annual growth scale, equating to over **1.5 years progress in 2024-25**.
- **43% of HIT math** students made twice the progress they were expected to achieve by year's end.
- For students participating in ELA tutoring in 2024-25, the number of students that were at or above benchmark according to Acadience **increased from 21% to 33%, a 12 percentage point increase**.

Initiative timeline
