<p>Highly systematic, explicit, intensive and evidence-based instructional program designed for students who demonstrate persistent and significant struggles in mastering specific literacy skills, even after receiving high-quality core instruction and supplemental support.</p> <p>Interventions aim to address acute skill deficits and accelerate learning to bring students to grade-level proficiency.</p>	<p>An evidence-based resource designed to enhance and support student literacy development by providing additional practice opportunities on specific literacy skills (e.g., phonemic awareness, phonics, fluency, vocabulary, comprehension, writing).</p> <p>These programs are intended to bridge instructional gaps and provide enrichment. They <b>do not replace core instruction or intervention.</b></p>
